

SEMINAR OUTLINE

Long COVID / post-COVID syndrome is an emerging condition and one about which we are continuing to learn more with ever-increasing exposure to affected patients.

This seminar will provide information about how the medium and long-term effects of Covid-19 are understood to manifest in different body systems.

Key issues that will be covered are:

- How both the virus and the vaccine breach barrier systems in the body
- Understanding what is happening and how to diagnose it
- Treating gut barrier and blood brain barrier breaches
- The effects of the vaccine on the cardiometabolic system
- How long covid overlaps with Mast Cell Activation Syndrome (MCAS) and what to do about it
- Dr Leo Galland's approach to Long Covid and how to relate that to AK
- Viral reactivation from SARS-Cov-2 and treatment protocols
- The importance of the Vagus Nerve and how to enhance function
- Neuroinflammation to Neurotoxicity

The weekend will aim to bring together all the latest research on the longterm effects of both covid infection and gene therapy vaccinations and present it in a manner that will allow you to apply it in a clinically useful way.

The weekend will involve muscle testing and requires basic knowledge in Applied Kinesiology techniques and concepts.

There will be practical sessions throughout the weekend to cover the treatment procedures that you will learn.

Presenter – Tracy S Gates

Tracy S. Gates qualified as an osteopath in 1986, and qualified as a homeopath in 2017. She is also a member of the Institute for Functional Medicine.

Having practised for several years using osteopathy and cranial osteopathy, she studied Applied Kinesiology, successfully achieving her diplomate status in 1994.

As part of her diplomate she made a research study into the use of AK in treating Special Needs children. The research was further backed up by a period of time spent at the Peto Institute in Budapest; as well as study at the Institute for Research into Human Potential in Philadelphia.

Today, Tracy lectures in the UK, Russia and throughout Europe. She makes regular presentations of her study projects and ongoing research at various conferences in Europe and the USA.

Tracy is currently Past Chairperson of the International Council (I.C.) of ICAK, as well as being the International Representative for ICAK-UK.
